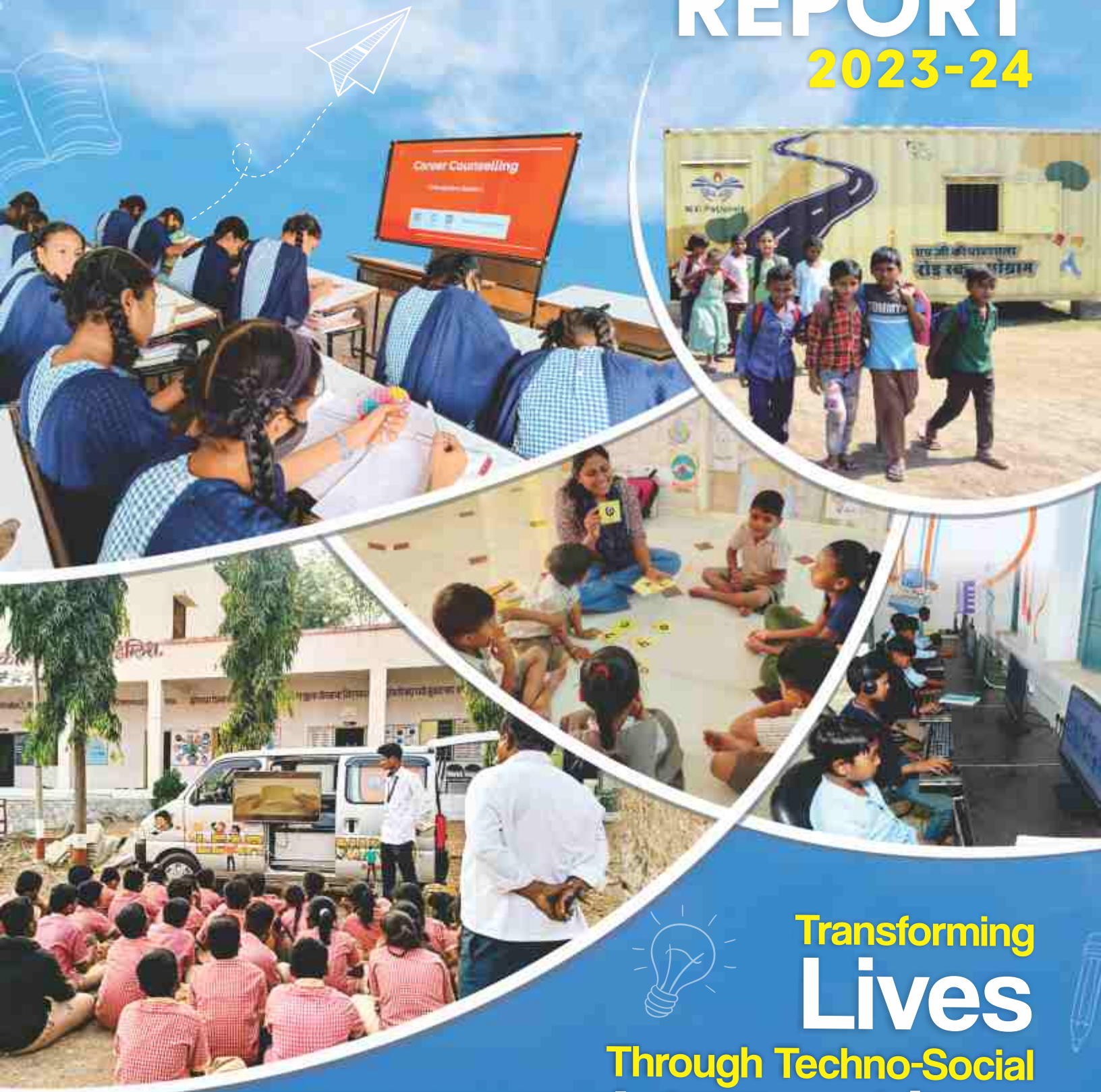

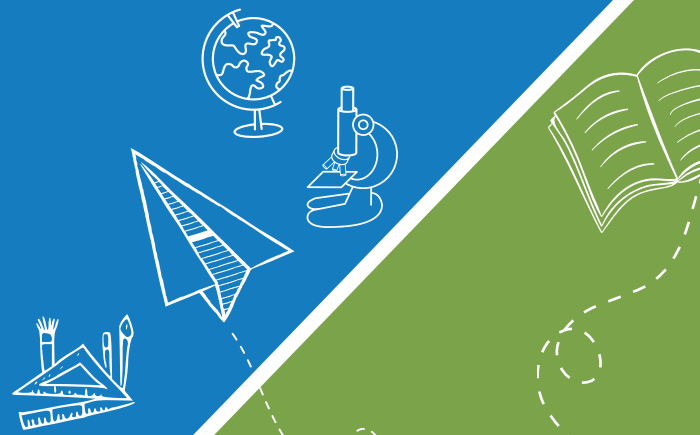


About MOINEE FOUNDATION

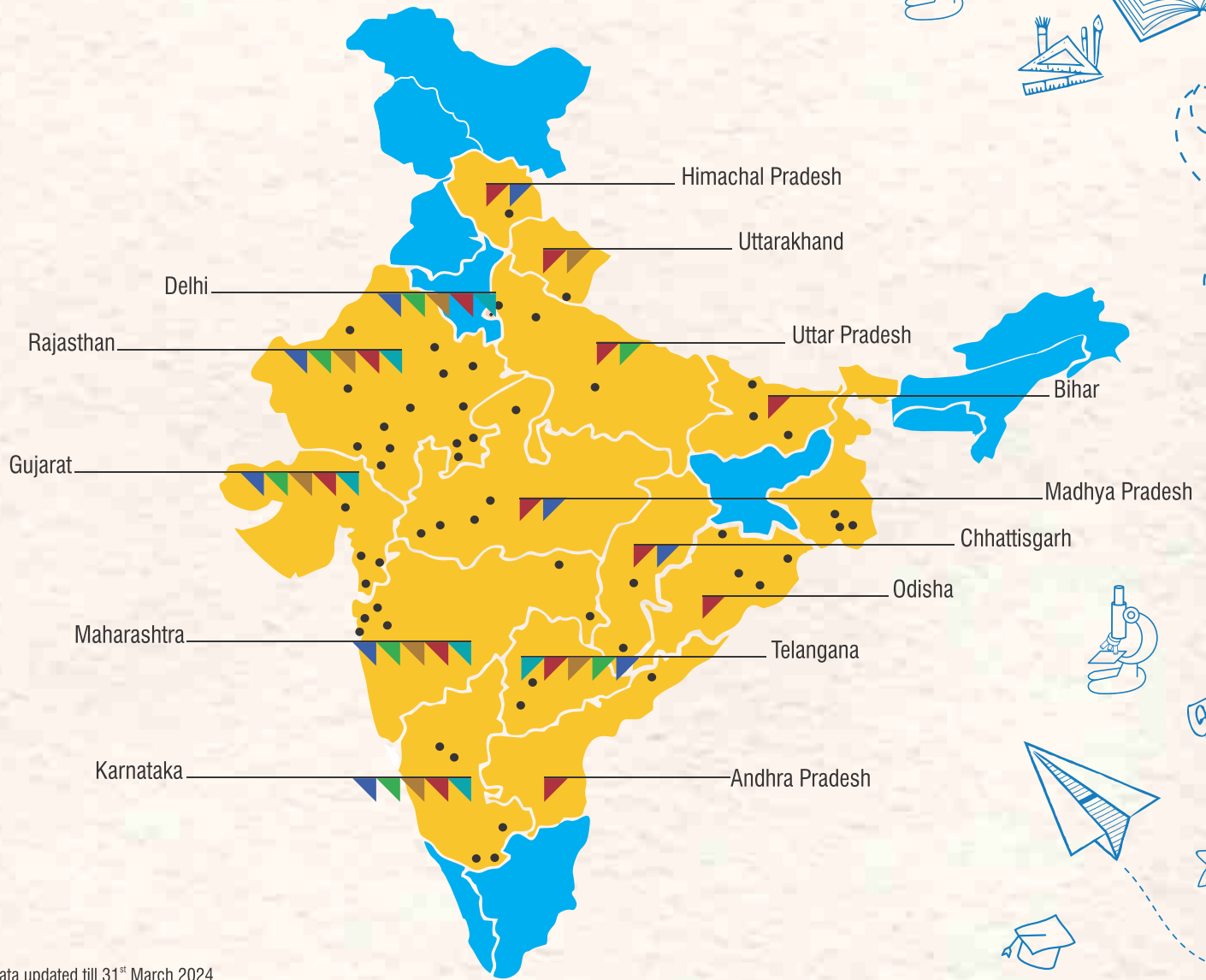

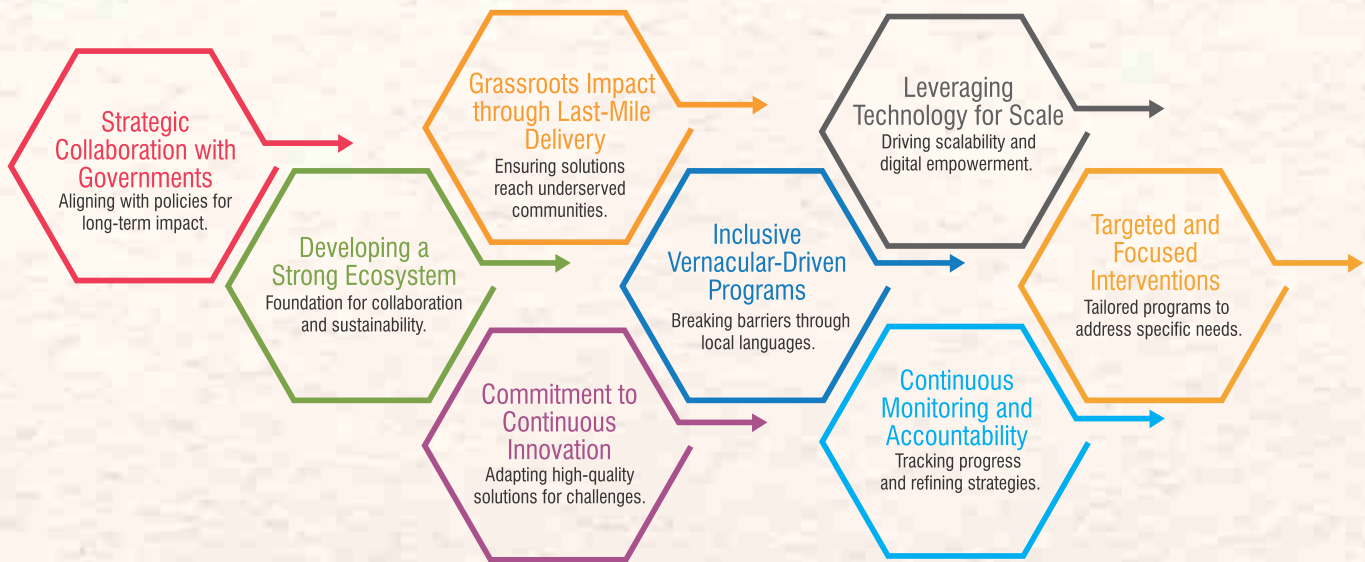

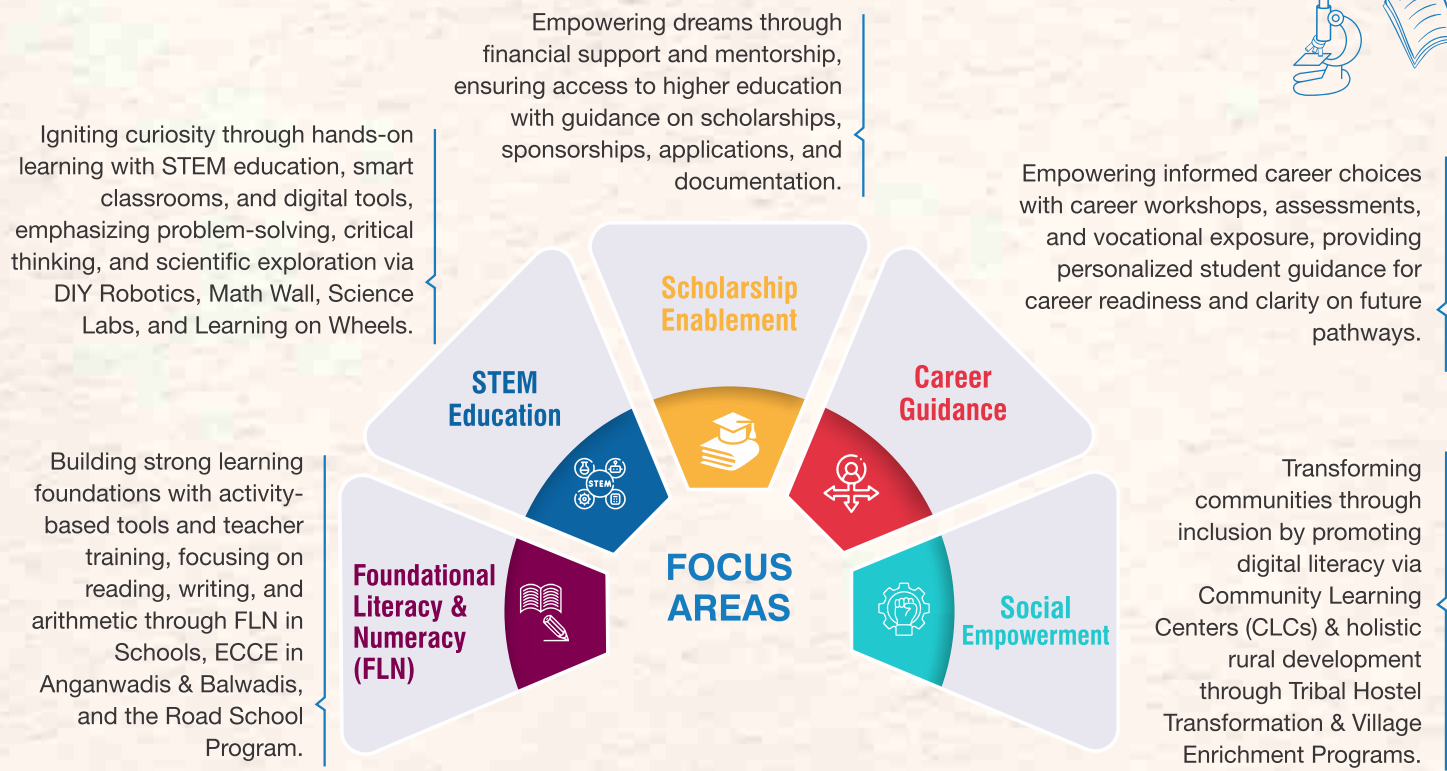

Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) is critical to ensuring that children in their early years acquire the essential skills of reading, writing, and arithmetic. Moinee Foundation's FLN programs are designed to provide engaging, child-friendly learning environments that build a strong foundation for lifelong learning. By addressing barriers in access, quality, and engagement, we empower students, educators, and communities to achieve sustainable educational outcomes.



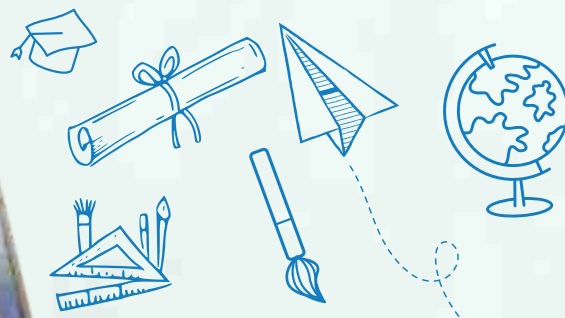
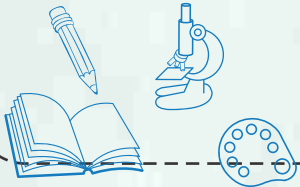
Bridging Barriers: Nandini's Journey to Education through the Road School Program

In the remote village of Kundra Majhra Gram Panchayat, Budaun (U.P.), 10-year-old Nandini faced significant challenges accessing education. The nearest government primary school was far, and during the rainy season, the unpaved roads became impassable, making regular attendance nearly impossible. Despite their hopes for her education, her parents felt powerless against these circumstances.

Hope arrived with the Road School Program, a CSR initiative by H.G. Infra Engineering Ltd, implemented by H.G. Foundation and executed by Moinee Foundation. Designed to strengthen Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN), the program brought quality learning closer to children in underserved communities. When the Road School opened in her village, Nandini's parents eagerly enrolled her, seeing it as the opportunity they had long wished for.

In the nurturing environment of the Road School, Nandini flourished. Dedicated educators, interactive lessons, and visual learning tools like projectors transformed subjects like mathematics into engaging experiences. "Watching her read confidently and solve math problems fills us with pride," shared her father.

Beyond academics, the program fostered confidence and community involvement, with parents actively participating in her progress. Today, Nandini's story stands as a powerful reminder of how accessible education can break barriers and unlock potential.

Integrating activity-based learning with story-based literacy modules, Quick Math tools, and regular teacher training to strengthen foundational literacy and numeracy skills in primary school students.

e-Vidya Model School Transformation Program

The e-Vidya Model School Transformation Program focuses on holistic transformation of government schools by enhancing infrastructure, digital learning, and teaching quality. This initiative has transformed 150 schools, benefiting 54000 students and teachers, and is supported by Vodafone Idea Foundation across 5 states and districts.



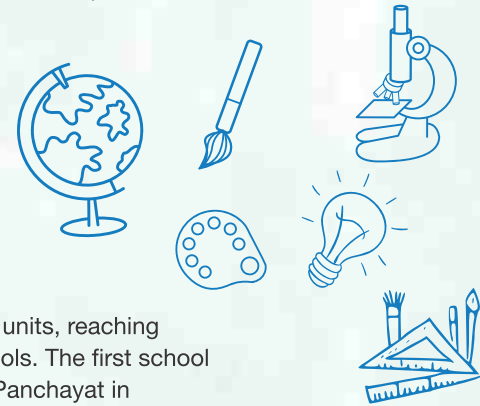
HG Ki Pathshala – Adoption of School Program

HG Ki Pathshala's Adoption of School Program provides comprehensive academic and infrastructural support to schools, ensuring long-term improvements. This initiative has adopted 16 schools, benefiting 4217 students & Teachers, with support from H.G. Foundation across 4 districts in Rajasthan.



HG Ki Pathshala – Road School Program

The Road School Program delivers education through mobile units, reaching remote communities with educational resources and digital tools. The first school was established in the remote areas of Kundra Majhra Gram Panchayat in Budaun district impacting more than 50 children with support from H.G. Foundation.

ECCE & FLN in Community Centers & Balwadis

The ECCE & FLN program strengthens early childhood education in Anganwadis and Balwadis by providing training, tools, and resources to improve foundational skills. This initiative is active in 13 Community Learning Centers (CLC) and 34 Balwadis aiming to help every child reach their full potential, supported by Vodafone Idea Foundation in 5 states and districts.



Learning on Wheels

Learning on Wheels brings education to remote areas via mobile units, equipped with digital tools and resources. The program reaches 7000 children & 6000 community members annually, supported by Vodafone Idea Foundation across 8 villages in Ahmedabad & Pune.



STEM EDUCATION & SMART CLASSES IN GOVT. SCHOOLS



STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) education is at the core of preparing students for the demands of the modern world. Moinee Foundation's STEM programs aim to spark curiosity, foster innovation, and develop problem-solving skills in students. By integrating hands-on learning and technology, we make STEM accessible and engaging, bridging gaps in resources and exposure in underserved communities.

Nurturing Aspirations Through Robotics: The Journey of Aishwary Sen

In Raipur, Chhattisgarh, Class 10 student Aishwary Sen dreamed of exploring technology but lacked access to advanced resources. His curiosity found wings when his school, Pt. R.D. Tiwari Govt. English Medium Utkrisht Vidyalaya, introduced a robotics lab through a program supported by Ericsson India, Vodafone Idea Foundation, and Moinee Foundation.

Aishwary's journey began with building a robotic crane and designing obstacle-avoiding robots using block programming. His talent extended to 3D modeling on Tinkercad, where he crafted designs like Chandrayaan and satellites. "The lab is my haven. It's where my ideas come to life," he shared. His innovative projects and participation in competitions have fueled his aspirations to pursue engineering. "Students like Aishwary show how the right resources can turn potential into achievement," his teacher remarked.

With over 10 robotics labs established across five states, benefitting 3,850 students, this initiative fosters a nationwide STEM ecosystem. Aishwary's success story reflects how Moinee Foundation's knowledge partnership is empowering young minds to innovate and dream big.

Learning on Wheels for Remote Schools:

Expanding STEM education in remote areas via mobile units with digital tools, STEM kits, and flexible schedules, ensuring inclusive learning and community engagement for sustainability.

Creating e-libraries with Offline Smart Knowledge Servers to offer quality STEM content, activity programs, and assessments, improving digital literacy and independent learning in underserved areas.

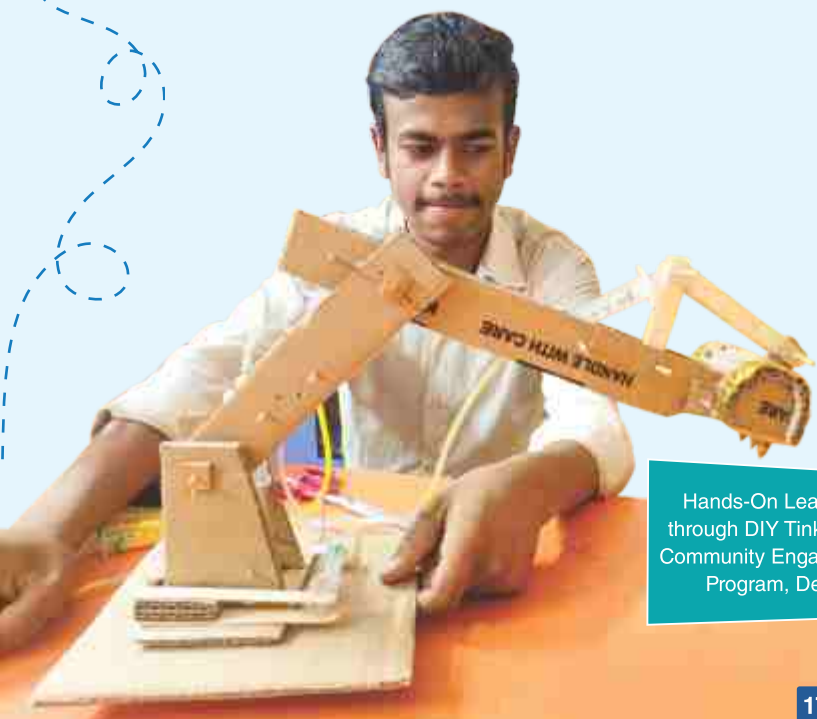
Transforming Lives

Through the Learning on Wheels Program

In Ode village of Gujarat, young Bhoi Vijay's potential was waiting to be discovered. Limited access to digital resources and skill development opportunities often restricted students like him from exploring their true capabilities. However, the Learning on Wheels initiative, supported by Vodafone Idea Foundation and implemented by Moinee Foundation, brought a transformative change.

Equipped with ICT tools, the Mini Mobile Van became a hub of learning, offering training in robotics, computer skills, critical thinking, and sports. For the past 1.5 years, Vijay has actively participated in these sessions, excelling in multiple areas. His dedication earned him several prizes and recognition from the program, boosting his confidence and skills. Beyond the program, Vijay's growth was evident in his school performance. He consistently secured the first position in various school competitions and even reached the taluka level in Kabaddi, where he achieved second place at the district level.

"The Learning on Wheels program helped me discover my potential. It made learning fun and rewarding," Vijay shared proudly. His journey reflects how accessible resources can unlock hidden talents and empower rural youth to excel in academics, sports, and life skills. The Learning on Wheels initiative continues to create similar success stories, bridging the digital divide and empowering rural communities with quality learning opportunities.

HG Ki Pathshala – Adoption of School Program

The program adopts government schools to enhance academic excellence and joyful learning through infrastructural and pedagogical support. Currently, 16 schools have been adopted, benefiting 4217 students and teachers, with support from H.G. Foundation in 4 districts of Rajasthan.



e-Vidya Model School Transformation Program

The e-Vidya Model School Transformation Program focuses on the holistic transformation of government schools by integrating smart classrooms, digital learning tools, and teacher capacity-building. It has transformed 150 schools, benefiting 54000 students and teachers, with support from Vodafone Idea Foundation across 5 states and districts.



Project Utkarsh School-In-A-Box

School-In-A-Box (REI MoU)
School-In-A-Box delivers smart education to remote areas by activating existing ICT infrastructure in government schools. It has reached 105 schools, impacting 30700 students & teachers, supported by partnerships under the REI MoU initiative across 10 districts in Rajasthan.



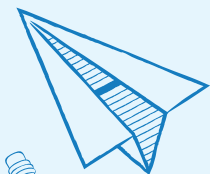
Freedom Through Digital Education

The initiative fosters digital literacy and technology-driven education in underserved regions, advancing students' skills for a digital future. The program has impacted 16684 students & 200 Teachers in 39 schools across 21 districts supported by 41 Clubs of India in 7 states.



School Transformation Project

Focused on modernizing government schools, this project incorporates Smart Classrooms to foster interactive learning. It has transformed Mahatma Gandhi Government School, Sisarwada in Pali, Rajasthan, benefiting 345 students and teachers, supported by HDFC Bank Ltd.





Co-Curricular Program

The program nurtures holistic development of students from Classes 6 to 12, emphasizing academic excellence, value education, career preparedness, & 21st-century skill development, focusing on STEM education, career guidance, & teacher capacity building, benefiting 35,555 students & teachers in 80 schools across Udham Singh Nagar, Lucknow, and Pune districts in three states, supported by Tata Motors Ltd.



Robotics Lab Program

The Robotics Lab Program introduces students to robotics and AI through fully equipped labs, fostering innovation and problem-solving skills. It has been implemented in 10 schools, engaging 3850 students across 5 states, supported by Vodafone Idea Foundation.



Learning on Wheels

Learning on Wheels brings mobile education units to underserved communities, equipping students with digital tools and resources. It annually reaches 7000 children & 6000 community members annually, supported by Vodafone Idea Foundation across 8 villages in Ahmedabad & Pune.



Computer Aided Learning Program (CAL)

The program builds students' computer literacy, offering training in both basic and advanced skills. It has reached 20 schools, impacting 8095+ students & teachers annually, supported by WNS Cares Foundation across Bengaluru & Indore.

CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM IN GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS



Career guidance plays a pivotal role in empowering students to make informed decisions about their future. Moinee Foundation's Career Guidance Program is designed to provide students in government schools with the resources, knowledge, and support they need to explore diverse career options, align their aspirations with opportunities, and build pathways for success.

Programs Under Career Guidance

Career Awareness Workshops

Empowering students in grades 9–12 with career insights through interactive sessions, resource kits, and role model talks, inspiring informed career planning and goal-setting.

Assessment & Group Counselling

Providing personalized career guidance using psychometric assessments, group discussions, and individualized action plans to help students identify strengths and make informed academic and career choices.

Vocational Exposure to Industrial Trades:

Introducing students to industrial careers through guided visits, hands-on demonstrations, and trade awareness campaigns, promoting skill-based career options and industry-aligned learning.

HG Ki Pathshala – Adoption of School Program

Supported by H.G. Foundation, the program has covered 500+ students in 10 schools, offering expert career counseling sessions, including goal setting, career planning, and educational pathways for Classes 10 & 12.



e-Vidya Model School Development Program

Supported by Vodafone Idea Foundation, the program has benefited 3000+ students from 20 schools, enhancing career awareness and decision-making for students in classes 9-12 through interactive workshops.



Community Engagement Program

Supported by Vodafone Idea Foundation, the initiative has engaged 200 youths across 13 CLCs, providing career assessment, exploration, and personalized guidance, boosting clarity and confidence in career choices.



HG Ki Pathshala – Tribal Hostel Transformation Program

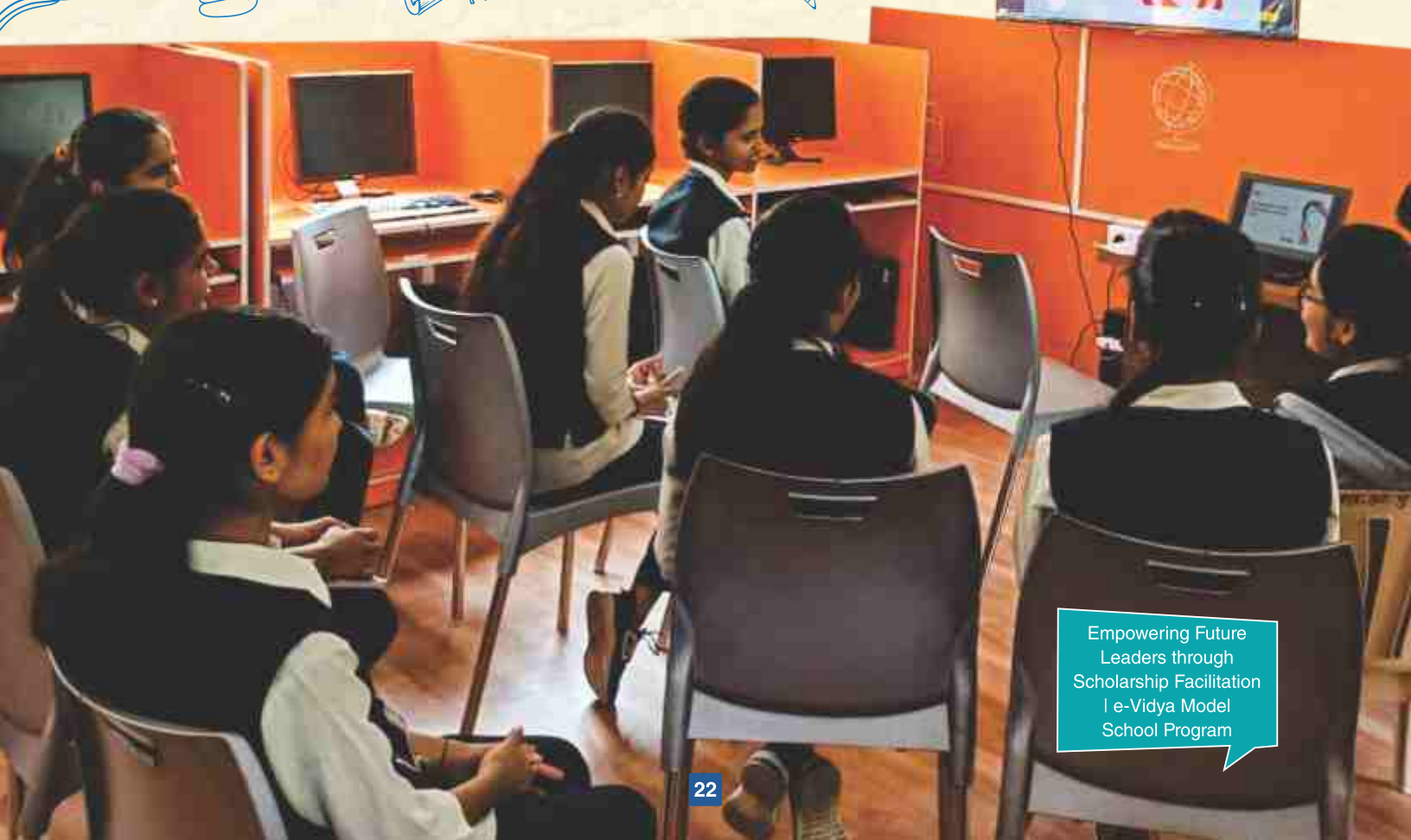

Cultivating Hope:

Kamala's Journey to Self-Reliance

In the remote village of Kailashpuri, Udaipur, Kamala, a widowed mother of six daughters, faced immense societal and financial challenges. Bound by traditional gender roles, she struggled to provide for her family but held onto the dream of a brighter future for her children.

When the Moinee Foundation, in collaboration with HG Foundation, introduced the Holistic Rural Development Program (HRDP) in her village, Kamala's life began to change. Through HRDP, she received hands-on training in flower farming, financial literacy, and market linkages, equipping her with the tools for self-reliance. With newfound skills and determination, Kamala cultivated marigolds on a small plot of land. Her first harvest not only brought her financial stability, with an additional 15,000 in regular income, but also boosted her confidence. Encouraged by her success, she expanded into vegetable farming, transforming once-barren land into a source of sustenance for her family.

"I never imagined this small piece of land could bring so much change to my life. The support I received has made me believe in my potential," Kamala shared. Today, she inspires other women in her village to pursue similar ventures, proving that true empowerment creates ripple effects in the community. Kamala's story reflects the power of inclusive development, where the right tools and support can transform not just one life but entire communities.



OUR ONGOING INITIATIVES TRANSFORMING COMMUNITIES TOGETHER



Village Enrichment Program

The Village Enrichment Program bridges the gap between rural communities and Central Government schemes by conducting awareness campaigns, Aadhar enrollment drives, registration camps, and renewal assistance. It has benefited 2,191 community members, and is being implemented in Budaun district in Uttar Pradesh with support from H.G. Foundation.



Adoption of Villages Program

Aligned with the Sansad Adarsh Gram Scheme, this initiative transforms villages into model villages, emphasizing sustainable development in agriculture, health, education, infrastructure, and natural resource management. Currently active in 7 villages in Rajasthan, and has benefited over 7326+ community members, supported by H.G. Foundation.

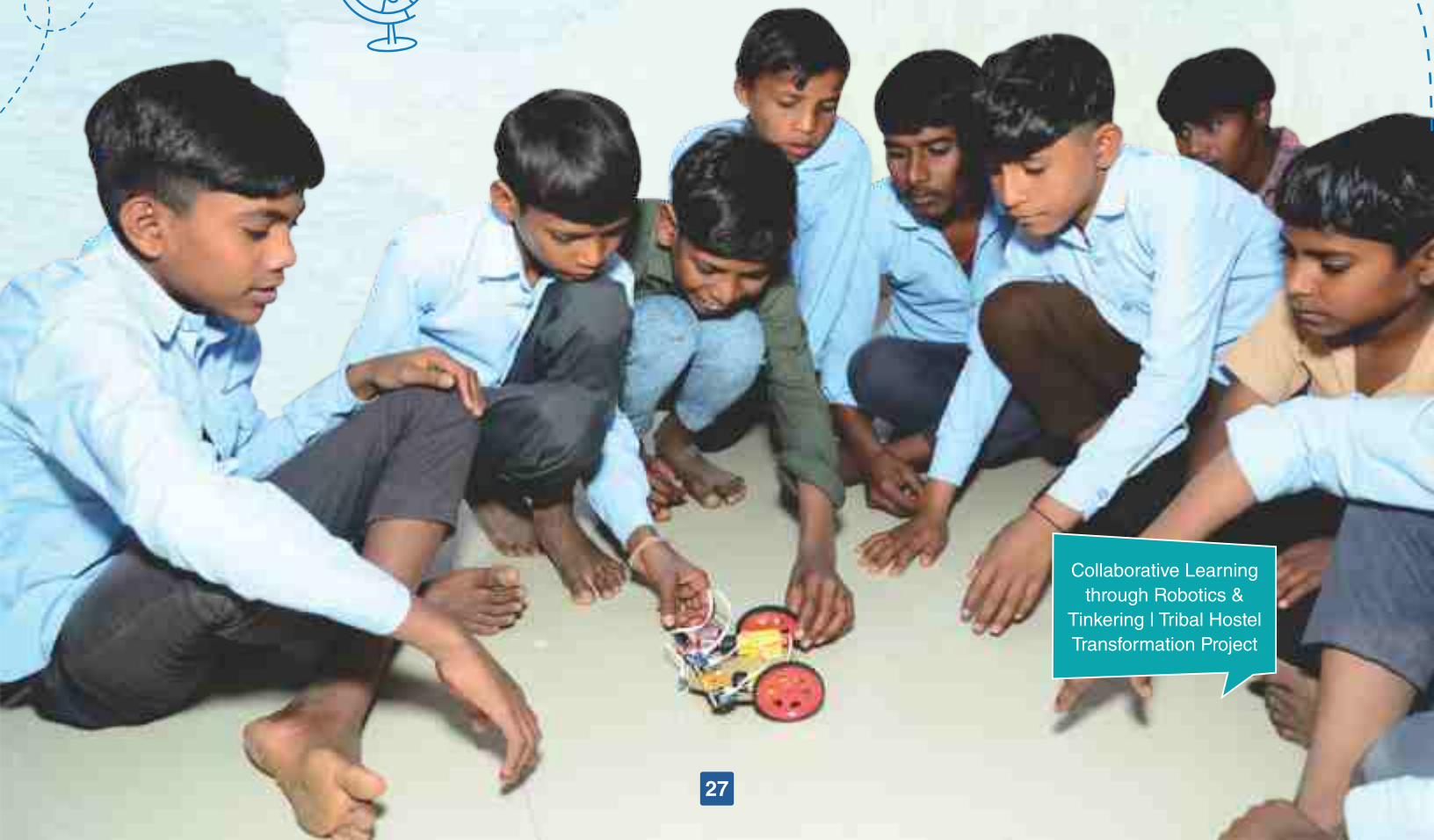
Tribal Hostel Transformation Project

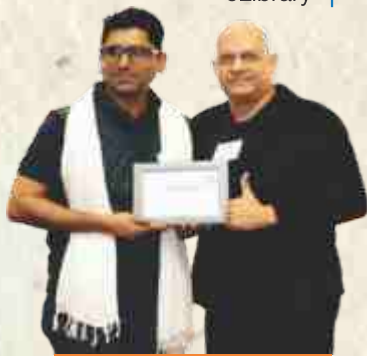
